RECOMMENDED DAY ITINERARIES

Option 1: Offshore Snorkeling & Marine Adventure Top Pick

- **08:30 – 09:00:** Disembark and meet boat tour at cruise terminal docks.
- **09:00 – 13:00 (Rose Island / Green Cay Excursion):** Boat ride to pristine natural reefs for snorkeling with tropical fish and sea turtles. Includes beach lounge time and optional swimming pig interaction.
- **13:00 – 14:30:** Return to port, enjoy lunch & live Bahamian music at the cruise terminal village.
- **15:30:** Reboard ship with peace of mind (well ahead of all-aboard).

Option 2: Iconic Landmarks & Paradise Island Glamour Sightseeing

- **09:00 – 10:30:** Walk through downtown landmarks (Pirates of Nassau, Queen's Staircase & Fort Fincastle).
- **10:45 – 14:00 (Paradise Island & Atlantis):** 10-minute water taxi to Atlantis Resort. Explore Marina Village, The Dig aquarium, or relax at Cabbage Beach.
- **14:30 – 15:30:** Short taxi ride back across the bridge to downtown for quick duty-free shopping.

Option 3: Cultural Markets & Local Food Walk Relaxed / Walking

- **09:30 – 11:00:** Shop straw hats and handcrafted souvenirs at the bustling Nassau Straw Market.
- **11:15 – 12:15:** Visit historic Buena Vista Estate & sample rum at John Watling's Distillery.
- **12:30 – 14:30:** Walk to Arawak Cay (Fish Fry) for fresh conch salad, conch fritters, and cold Kalik beer.
- **14:30 – 15:30:** Dip toes in Junkanoo Beach on the casual 15-minute stroll back to the ship.

Offshore Island Snorkeling Guide

- **Rose Island:** Best for vibrant natural coral reefs, sea turtle encounters, and boat excursion vibes.
- **Pearl Island:** Organized private cay with guided reef snorkeling, sunken statues, lunch buffet, and kayak rentals.
- **Blue Lagoon:** Calm, shallow lagoon waters tailored for relaxed wading and dolphin/marine animal encounters.

Must-Try Bahamian Food & Drinks

- **Fresh Conch Salad:** Raw diced conch tossed with sweet peppers, onions, citrus juice & goat pepper.
- **Conch Fritters:** Deep-fried seasoned batter served with spicy Calypso dip.
- **Bahama Mama:** Iconic rum punch with pineapple, coconut & grenadine.
- **Local Beers:** Refreshing ice-cold *Kalik* or *Sands*.

Cruiser Survival Tips: 1) Always keep watches set to **Ship Time**, not local mobile network time. 2) Book excursions that return by **1:30 – 2:00 PM** to maintain a safe 2+ hour return buffer. 3) Bring ship pool towels, water shoes, reef-safe sunscreen, and USD cash for tips and small market vendors.
